The Talking Tactile Tablet, also known as TTT or T3, enables audio-tactile learning and fun. The TTT connects via USB to a computer. Children and adults place one of many touchable overlays on the TTT. As they explore raised-line and textured images and braille text, users can press down on any part to hear audio descriptions or to interact with programs. Touch Graphics and its partners have created educational applications and authoring tools for the TTT, and it is currently in wide use around the world. The TTT is inexpensive and very easy to use.
